

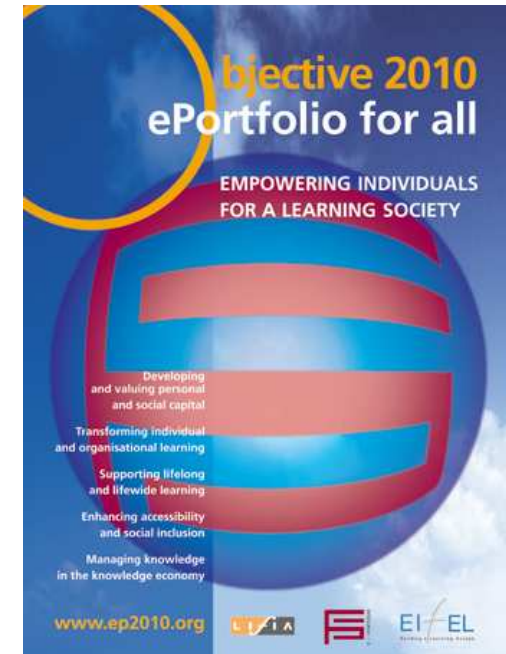

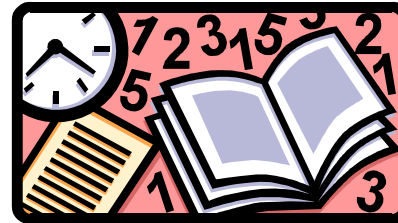


EIFEL - Europortfolio

Before beginning work on eportfolios, in April 2004, my role was eLearning Mentor, a role which involved me in providing support and guidance to teaching colleagues. This support was partly technical but was mainly rooted in my own teaching experience which included 4 years working at the School of Education. One of the most challenging roles, leading up to my move to CeLT, was the development of online materials for the Post Graduate Certificate in Higher Education (PGCertHE). 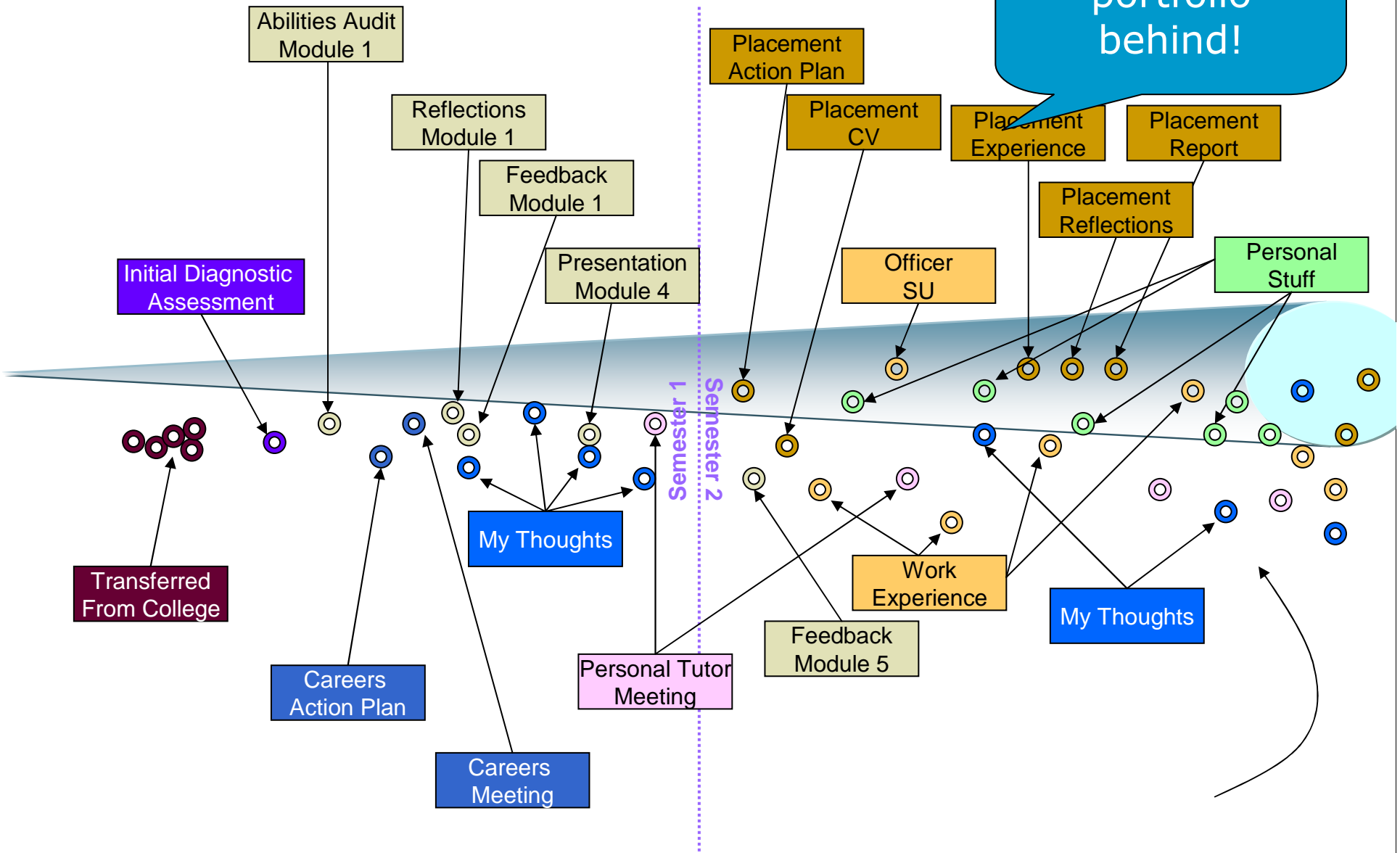
Since being with CeLT I have been involved in many exciting projects. One of the first of these was the design and delivery of a Technology Retreat. The retreat was a 1 week residential project for 10 academic staff. During the retreat delegates were required to produce effective elearning materials for online delivery. I have also presented two papers based on the retreat and have included details of one such [presentation and my reflections](#) on the paper I presented at ALT-C 2004.

My current work is concerned with the development of the ePortfolio system to support the Progress File project which has resulted in my ePortfolio work.
