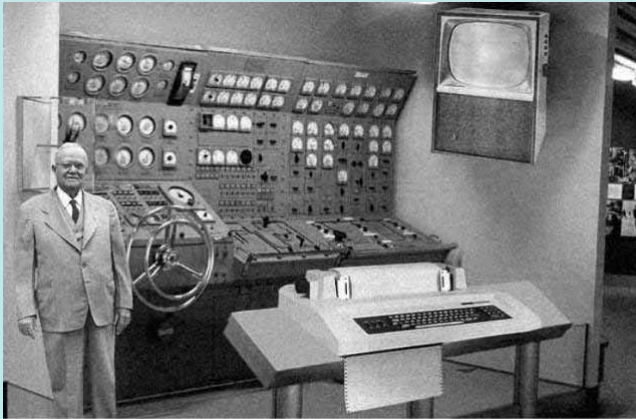


The new innovation landscape

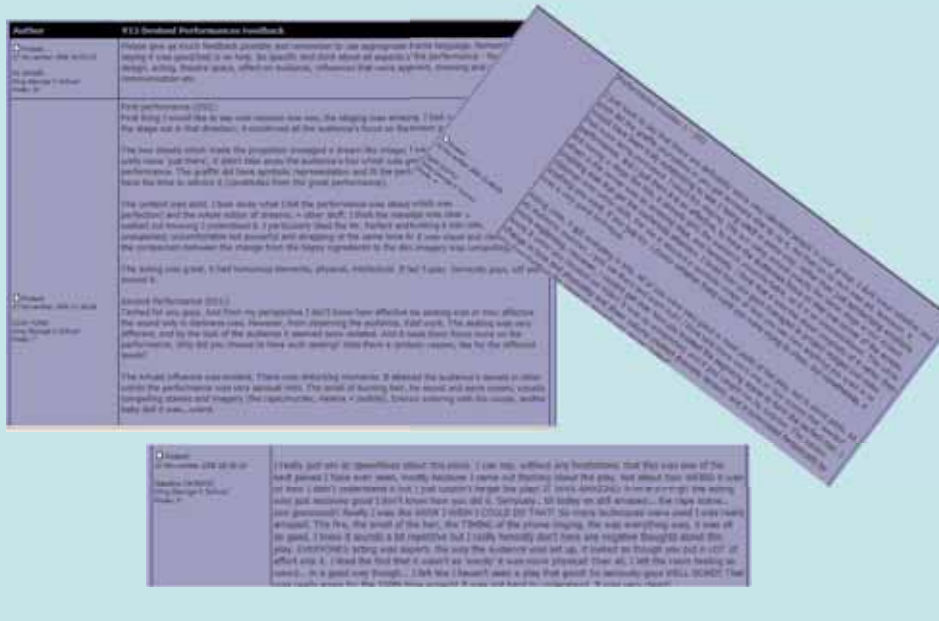

A Portfolio, at it's simplest level, is a record of your learning journey and learning conversations

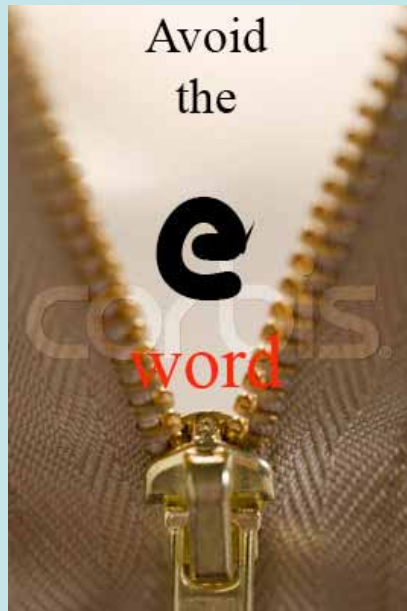
Portfolios must be accessible to other learners

Don't fight them join them!. Ignore Web 2.0 applications at your peril. Think about mashing it up. Avoid making rules.

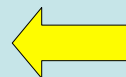
Secondary schools are problematic and current practice is inhibiting

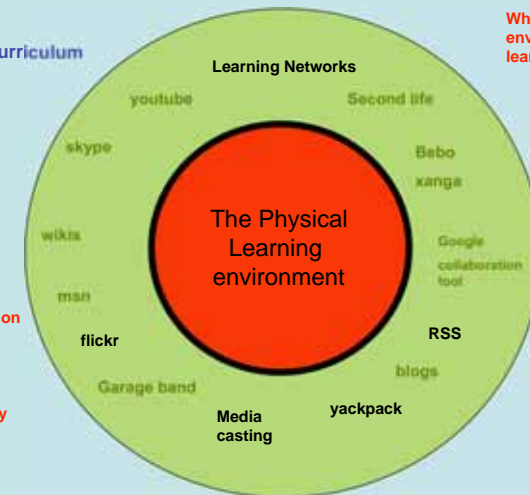
